- Hours may vary, without notice, due to changes in weather, attendance, or special events.
- TOSA POOL is committed to providing a comfortable and safe environment for all our guests. We have established minimum adult to child ratios for patrons visiting our facility.
- **SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS**
 - Daytime Open Swim
 - > One adult (18 yrs. or older) to 2 children age 4 and younger.
 - > One adult (18 yrs. or older) to 4 children age 5 - 6.
 - > One chaperone (16 yrs. or older) to 4 children age 7 - 10.
 - > Children age 11 and older may attend without a chaperone.
 - Evening Open Swim
 - > One adult (21 yrs or older) to 2 children age 4 and younger.
 - > One adult (21 yrs or older) to 4 children/youth ages 5 - 17.
- Recreational activities and classes available through the Wauwatosa Recreation Department at Tosarec.com.
- Facility Rentals and Birthday Party Package information available on our website.
- The Friends of Hoyt Park & Pool is a 501(c)(3) non-profit operating the TOSA POOL at HOYT PARK under the terms of a 55-year lease with Milwaukee County.
