As a result, K4, with 23 students, has Patty Higgins as a classroom aide to assist Mrs. Cira. K5, with 26 students, has two classroom aides (Leah Seeley in the morning and Mrs. Wellenstein in the afternoon.) And 1st grade, with 28 students, was approved for two full-time teachers (Mrs. Kozina and Ms. Thayer.) Total enrollment for the school is 328 students.
- A welcome back to Mrs. Conklin who will be job sharing the K5 teaching position with Mrs. Pagoria . Mrs. Pagoria will teach Monday, Tuesday and Wednesdays, and Mrs. Conklin will teach Thursdays and Fridays starting this week.
