The theme this year is "Mission: Healthy Choices". The theme will be broken down into "stations" where various spy missions will be solved and include:

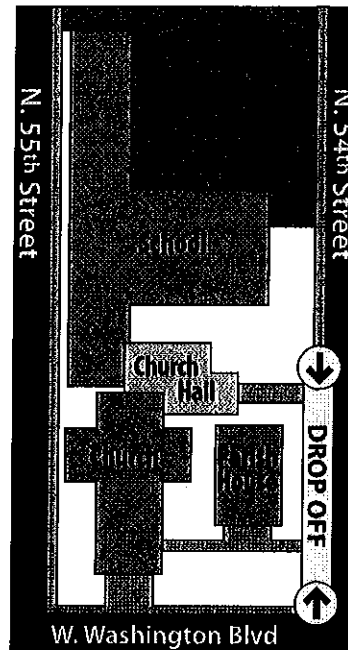
1. Food Choices

K4/K5 HID DROP-OFF LOCATION



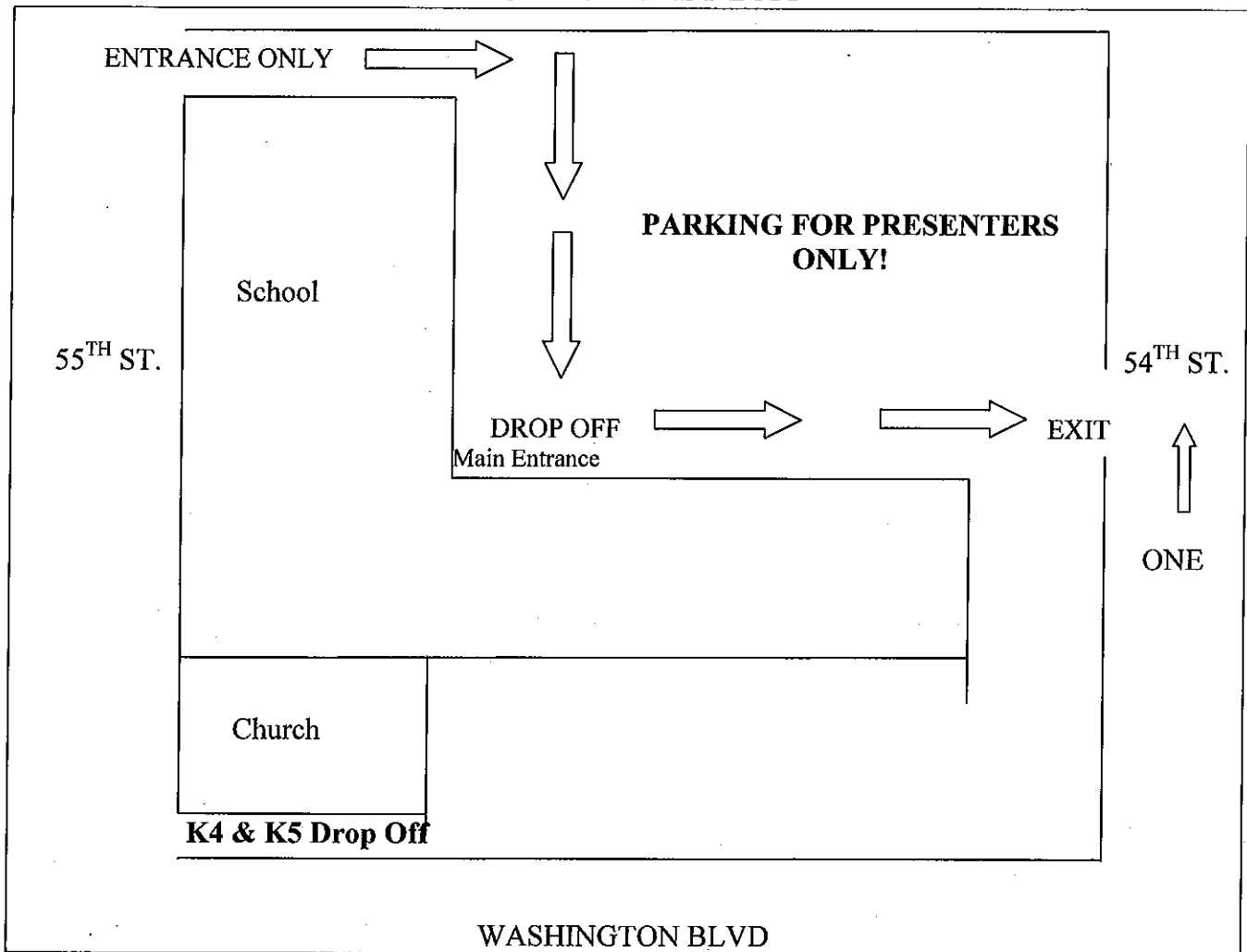
You will need to come into the Church Hall for **PICK UP** at 11:30.
