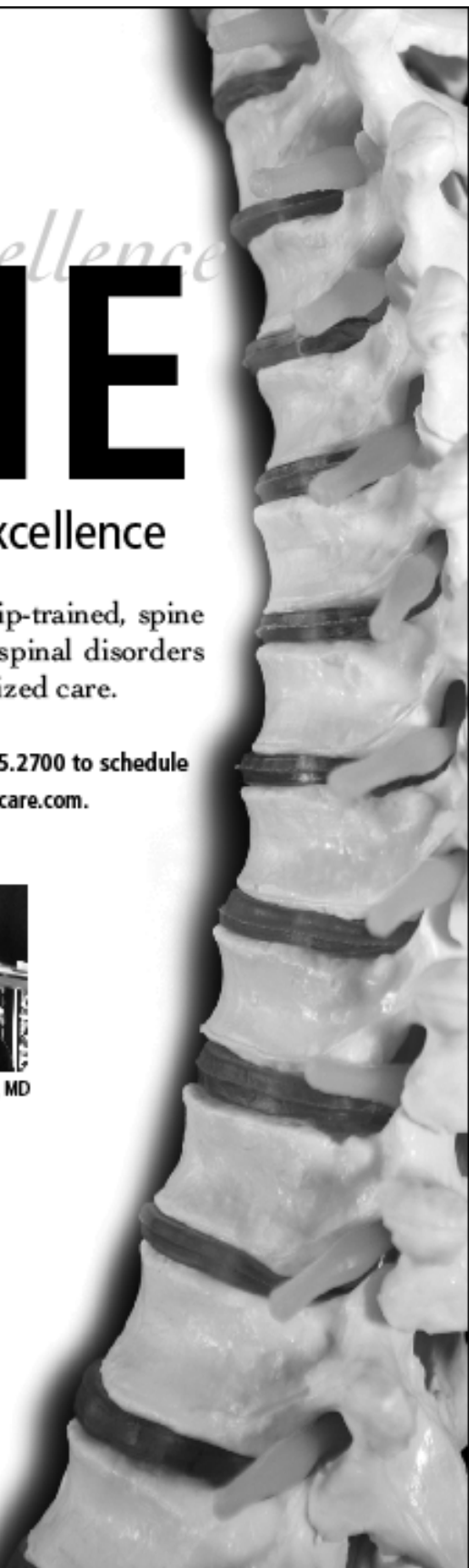

1. Persons wishing to bid on Silent Auction, or "S" series items, must do so by writing their name, paddle number and the bid amount in an acceptable increment on the top-most available space on the bid sheet.
2. Each bid must exceed the prior bid established for the item to constitute a valid bid. Bid increments will be posted on each bid sheet.
3. Under no circumstances may a bid sheet be removed from the bidding table.
4. If a silent item is in a bidding war at the time the table closes, a St. Sebastian Auction representative may declare an "instant voice auction" on that item and begin gathering voice bids until a winning bidder is declared.
5. In the event of a dispute, a St. Sebastian Auction representative official shall act as a final authority and shall determine the winning bid.
6. All sales are final. Successful bidders may pay with cash, check, Visa or MasterCard. Payment in full is required before the item can be picked up.
7. Winners will be posted when the tables are closed. The bank will be open to accept payment beginning at 9:30 p.m. Pre-registered bidders will receive receipts at that time.
8. Please pick up your invoice sheet at the RECEIPT table. Take the invoice to the cashier to pay for your items and pick up any gift certificates.
9. Present your paid receipt to the Auction Host at the bidding table to claim your item.
