**CONFERENCES AND NO SCHOOL THIS WEEK** – School is dismissed at 11:30 today for Parent-Teacher conferences, with no school Thursday and Friday. Conferences for grades K4 – 2 should involve only the teacher and parents. Conferences for grades 3 – 8 involve the teacher, parents and students. Conferences for the first grading period are mandatory and a day of absence will be recorded for those families who do not attend conferences. For middle school families, the recommendation is to see your child’s homeroom teacher and any other teachers you feel it is important to see. You do not need to see every middle school teacher.

Conferences are by appointments for grades K4 – 5 and Specials teachers. Grade 6 – 8 teachers will be in classrooms for conferences. You need to wait in line to see them. Middle school teachers have a five minute timer! The timer will be used to keep the conferences moving along and are provided so every family gets a chance to see middle school teachers without long lines and long conferences. If there are multiple middle school children in a family, you will get five minutes per child.
