What is Readers Are Leaders?

Readers Are Leaders (RAL) is a program sponsored by Home and School to promote extracurricular reading and encourage students to improve their reading. It is intended to compliment classroom reading instruction.

Who can participate in Readers Are Leaders?

RAL has something for everyone at every grade level.

ROSIE READER/ 4K & 5K

Rosie Reader visits the kindergarten rooms regularly and encourages children to read. Children receive forms for their parents to keep track of the number of minutes they read together. The sheets represent one letter in the word R-E-A-D-I-N-G and after each sheet is turned in, the child receives recognition in the school newsletter and a small prize. Once all seven sheets are turned in, the child receives a book prize.

ACCELERATED READER (AR)/ Grades 1-8

Students read books either in their classroom or at home and then take brief comprehension quizzes on the school computers to earn points. The more books they read and the more quizzes they take and pass, the more points they earn! And of course, the better they will become at reading!

Quizzes can be taken during class time (with teacher's permission), class Library time, Lunch Bunch, or after school on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Students set personal point goals at the beginning of each quarter. If they reach their goal before the quarter's end, they receive a reward.

Quarter 2 – November 9 – January 22 Reward given the week of January 25th.

Quarter 3 – January 25 – March 26 Reward given the week of March 29th.

Quarter 4 – March 29 – June 4 Reward given the week of June 7th.

End of year contests:

- top point earner for the year in each class will receive a pizza lunch
- class with the most points for the year will receive an ice cream party

S.S. READER/ Grades 3-8

S.S. Reader is a student newspaper that comes out three times a year. Students who have a strong interest in writing and sharing information about our school are encouraged to participate. If you would like more information, contact Ms. Clermont (Computers).

What can parents do? Encourage your child to read **every** day!

- o Encourage your child to take Accelerated Reader quizzes on the books they have read. It will give them feedback as to how well they are reading and reward them with points for their reading.
- o Routinely ask them how many points they have earned, and how close they are to meeting their quarterly AR goal.

St. Sebastian YAC requires that each family take a turn (or turns, depending on number of players you have engaged in basketball teams) to staff the snack stand and the admission table for these home games.

Attached is the Snack Stand schedule for the season (Times vary due to availability of player families (some teams have more players than others) and number of games and game times during a given day. Coaches and assistant coaches are not scheduled for the snack stand/admissions duties.

If you are unable to work the hours that you have been assigned, it is your responsibility to trade times/dates with another family. Please keep the following in mind when you are working:

- Only one adult per family is required to work the scheduled hours
- In the event that someone does not show up for their shift, please ask another parent of your team to help out and let me know of the change to credit that family and address the missing family make up time
- At least one adult must be staffing the snack stand and one adult must remain at the admission table at all times
- Do not bring small children behind the snack stand counter
- Children are not allowed in the back room and should not be removing anything from that area (balls, equipment, etc.)
