

#### **Treasurer's Report – Patty Walsh**

- Fish Fry profit from October fish fry was \$42 (lots of start up costs in October)
- Fish Fry profit from November was \$3,388 (last year in November was just over \$2,000)
- Shelly is looking into purchasing scrip certificates for staff
- Two AED machines were purchased. The cost was \$2,972, but this was covered by two grants that Patty Walsh wrote. Training is going on right now. Thanks to Patty for being a "lifesaver" for our school, parish and families. Over \$3,000 was raised to help with the training costs. As we get more people trained on the machines, we will need extra funds to continue the training.
- The first installment of our pledge to the Parish (\$10,000) has been paid.

## Principal's Report

- Math Computation Improvement Plan – Beginning 12/3/09
  - Math Achiever club – software – some pieces will be a contest – voluntary and can be done at school during down times
  - Written Math Test – Grades 4-8 and Grades 1-3 will do this.
    - Student Website Work – at home practice – internet math practice within each grading period (Grades 6-8 – 4 hours; Grades 3-5 – 4 hours; Grades 1-2 – 2 hours). Parent will sign when their child finishes. May be integrated into the math grade.
  - Math Computation Wall of Fame – grade level math computation. High scorers will be added to the Wall of Fame.
  - Open House will be on January 31st
    - Lawn signs will be ordered to advertise our school.

  - Recycling issue – Tracey talked to Greg Smrz about upping our recycling program. Having containers and a service to pick up the recycling is expensive. One solution may be as groups sign up to use rooms in the Gathering Space they would take their recycling with them (plastic, cans, etc.). For Fish Fry or cafeteria use, people would volunteer to take recycling home. This would be a great community service. We're still working on solutions for this problem.
