

## ACCELERATED READER for Students in Grades K5 - 8

The student is to read a book for enjoyment and then take a brief quiz as soon as possible after reading the book. The more the student reads, the more quizzes he/she can take and the more points she/he will earn.

### How to take a quiz:

1. Students can test on books read by themselves, their teachers or parents, or other readers.
2. Students then take a quiz on the content of the book at a computer.

### When to take a quiz:

1. Time for taking a quiz in the library is during **open library times**, possibly during Lunch Bunch with a ticket, or after school on some Wednesdays or Thursdays.
2. During your class library time, you will need to have your books checked out before taking a quiz.
3. To take a quiz in your classroom, you will need to follow the guidelines set by your teacher.

Students' points are saved and will be used toward a class activity or personal prize depending on the activity planned for that period of time.

### What Can Parents Do?

1. Encourage your child to read. Look for the printout of the quizzes as they take them.
2. Join the Readers Are Leaders team. They always need help coordinating and staffing events.
3. Give new or gently used books or donations of money for new books to the library. We are now accepting gently used books with a copyright more recent than 1999.

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
